RESUME - March 2021

Richard McBee, born in New York City, studied painting at the Art Students League of New York. His subject matter has been drawn from the Bible and Jewish history since 1976. Since 2008 he has focused on the pivotal role of women in Biblical narratives.

The 'Biblical Artists' (Bradford, McBee, Siani, Silberman) mounted numerous exhibitions in the late 1970's and 1980's. In 1996 he exhibited 24 major paintings on "Abraham & Isaac" at the Synagogue for the Arts, New York. In 2010 he exhibited "Sarah's Trials," a series of 16 large paintings on the life of the biblical matriarch, Sarah, at the JCC Manhattan.

McBee was Program Director of the Alliance of Figurative Artists in the 1980's and in 1991 was one of the founding members of the American Guild of Judaic Art. In 2008 he helped found the Jewish Art Salon to promote contemporary Jewish Art through exhibitions and lectures.

He reviewed the Jewish Arts scene from 2000 to 2014 in The Jewish Press and made occasional contributions to the Forward, the Jewish Week, JewishIdeasDaily.com and Mosaicmagzine.com. He is member of the International Association of Art Critics. His artwork has been discussed in Matthew Baigell's "Jewish Art in America" (2006) and "Jewish Identity in American Art" A Golden Age since the 1970's": Chapter Ten (2020) and featured in a full review of his Akeida paintings in Ars Judaica (Vol 5, 2009). He is also featured in "Tradition and Transformation: Three Millennia of Jewish Art and Architecture" by Ori Z. Soltes. McBee continues to exhibit, lecture and curate exhibitions on Jewish Art. His artwork is in many private collections throughout the country. His website; richardmcbee.com, exhibits over 300 of his artworks and 225 of his Jewish Art reviews.
